Dear Mr. Rush:

Many thanks for the copy of your dangerous animal ordinance last June. Tulare County adopted an ordinance patterned after yours and it has been implemented with no major problems.

I added two clauses of my own to the recent drafting efforts. One, a definition of "attack", was included in our new ordinance. A copy is enclosed. The other is an attempt to reach the owners of de facto guard dogs which pose a problem for unsuspecting trespassors or invitees, especially children. A copy of this clause, entitled "Dogs Guarding Unenclosed Property" is also enclosed. It was not adopted because the board of supervisors expressed a desire to save it for a comprehensive look at guard dog regulation.

We are in the process of drafting a guard dog ordinance. Any sample ordinances or regulations you can provide will be greatly appreciated.


