Thank you for your letter of February 26, 1985, requesting information regarding requirements for training "attack dogs" in the City of Los Angeles. While we do not use the designation "attack dogs", we do have purview in the regulation of Sentry Dogs and Sentry Dog Trainers.

I have enclosed a portion of the City of Los Angeles Municipal Code, the sections pertaining to Animal Regulation. Marked for your reference in blue is Section 53.64, REGULATION OF SENTRY DOG TRAINERS, amended effective 11/6/82. The regulations are quite explicit and detailed with both the trainer and the individual animals requiring qualification and permit by this Department.

I hope these regulations will answer your questions. However, if you need further information, please do not hesitate to contact me.
